The CTA Intermodal Steering and Planning Committee voted to recommend that CTA President Richard Bartolic appoint a Clean Air Action Plan Task Force. This group will provide oversight and direction in CTA's opposition to the San Pedro Bay Ports Clean Air Action Plan (CAAP) and development of CTA's own Intermodal Clean Air Plan.

This Task Force consists of 8 CTA Intermodal Conference members and an advisory group made up of CTA's Policy Committee Chairpersons and CTA senior staff. The Task Force will coordinate strategy, develop action plans, and track progress and results. The Task Force will report back to and work with the Intermodal Steering and Planning Committee and the CTA Intermodal membership at large.

**CTA plans to hire a contractor and public relations firm to assist with these efforts. The cost of these contractors will be funded by the CTA's Intermodal Conference members and others through voluntary contributions.** The funds will be placed in an 'Intermodal restricted account' and not used for CTA's general budget purposes. The level of these contractor costs will depend on the duration of the CAAP approval and/or legal process. All voluntary contributions for this effort are welcome.
